CV12 ACUPOINT

Front point of the Stomach

CV12 is located on the anterior midline, 6 fingers above to the umbilicus.

► ACUPUNCTURE POINT USED FOR (According to TCM):

Stomach discomfort

(Stomach pain, Bloatiness or distention and lack of appetite, etc.)

Digestion problems



LOCATION: Between the eyebrows.


ACUPUNCTURE POINT USED FOR (According to TCM):

Insomnia, agitation and restlessness.



GV14 ACUPOINT

GV14 is located on the midline, below the spinous process of the 7th cervical vertebra (C7).

HOW TO FIND GV14

Flex and extend your head slightly forward, C7 will remain fixed and wont move forward with the neck.

GV14 is located below the spinous process of C7.

Place a patch right between C7 and T1.





LOCATION: Just inferior to the top of the sternum, below the Neck Dimple.


ACUPUNCTURE POINT USED FOR (According to TCM):

PATCHING EXPERIENCE

RIGHT SHOULDER & THIGH PAIN

SHOULDER & RIGHT THIGH PAIN

Shared By Bob from USA, received on 12 June, 2015

One of my most challenging patching experiences was with a woman that was thrown from a horse hurting her right shoulder and right thigh. I have always been taught to work on the worst pain first so I started with the shoulder. I used the cross method, added glutathione, carnosine, aeon, etc. and nothing worked. And, of course, I was in front of a room full of people who were watching the patches not work! After about 20 minutes, I thought, "Maybe the two pains are connected." So I placed the white patch directly on the pain in her thigh. She got really dizzy for a few seconds and had to sit down. I was a bit concerned and asked her how she felt.. She said as soon as I put the patch on her thigh, she felt a wave move through her body and when the wave went away, so did the pain. I've used this technique of working with pain in two separate locations resulting from the same incident since then and have had a great deal of success getting rid of both pains quickly.



RIGHT SHOULDER & THIGH PAIN OUR INTERPRETATION

STEP 1: In cases of having 2 areas of pain simultaneously, First, place an ICE WAVE Tan at Point of Pain of higher intensity. In this example at the Right Shoulder.

STEP 2:Then, place an ICE WAVE White at **Point of Pain** of lower intensity. In this example at the Right Thigh.

I'll comeback in 5 minutes and if still isn't, we will help her...", Help her?..., well, that's the worst option ever (In my opinion)... anyway, Dr. was gone for a moment so, I took my car key and pressed firmly with it BL67 position on my wife's left foot, after a while I changed to BL67 position on my wife's right foot, well, nothing happened... Then, I started again at the left foot and suddenly my wife shouted: "SHE MOVED!!"... Dr. came back, saw the situation and said: "Mmhh, the Baby is now in position, we are ready to start...".

Just by pressing the right Acupuncture Point. Beautiful...

BABY'S POSITION AT LABOUR

BL67 ACUPOINT

LOCATION: In the outer corner of the little toe's nail, at the junction of lines drawn along the lateral border of the nail and the base of the nail.

ACUPUNCTURE POINT USED FOR (According to TCM):

Malposition of fetus, difficult labor.

PATCHES TO TEST:

None, the best is to press it firmly with a sharp object like a pen or even a car key...
